Letter Dated the 6th of December, 2002 Signed by Prabhakaran

191. The warrants to search executed at the World Tamil Movement headquarters and related facilities have yielded a mountain of evidence that depicts the group as the figure head of the LTTE in Canada taking instruction from, and liaising with, the leaders of the LTTE in order to advance their mandate of funding terror in Sri Lanka. For example, a document seized from the office location of the World Tamil Movement, dated the 6th day of December, 2002, addressed to "the In-charge, Canadian Office" is signed by Velupillai PRABHAKARAN. The original document is written in Tamil and was translated by TCE#1 on the 26th day of May, 2006. This item is identified as Exhibit Number 19-01, seized by Constable BICKLE on the 23rd day of April, 2006, at 39 Cosentino Drive. I have set out below in italics the translation of this item, a copy of these materials is attached to "Appendix 13" at Tab A.

I wish to convey my greetings to the In-charge of the Canadian section of Liberation Tigers of Tamil Eelam.

I take great pleasure in conveying to you that the contribution you made through your offices has been instrumental in making our nation walk with heads up (meaning with pride) in this critical juncture of the liberation struggle. I thank and congratulate you, members of your organization and the people of Tamil Eelam for this.

aware of the unpleasant thoughts and experiences of the past.

At this juncture, the war has paused, but not our struggle. On the other hand, it is very important that we intensify the struggle at this juncture.

Our nation needs to be strengthened in various aspects. Our national movement of Liberation Tigers of Tamil Eelam needs to be modernized in various fronts. Our nation's infrastructure needs to be rebuilt. The livelihood of our people, shattered by the war, needs to be given a new life again. In future, if the Sinhalese nation wages a war on our nation, we need to ensure that we are strong enough to fight it out with our full breath.

At the same time when we are engaged in peace efforts to alleviate race conflicts, we should be engaged in reconstruction efforts as well to strengthen our nation.

For the reconstruction efforts, with a privilege I look forward to receiving substantial contribution, from the displaced people of Tamil Eelam.

As per currently formulated plans, prior to June 30, 2003 we are expecting to receive Rs. 100 Crores (Rupees 10 Million) as contribution from our Tamil Brethren. Of this, Rs. 50 Crores (Rupees 5 Million) has to reach us before March 31, 2003. Then only we will be able to complete our planned activities.

I request the Canadian Office to take responsibility of contributing Rs. 15 Crores of the above amount. I also request you to contribute this amount in a timely manner so that all planned activities are completed on schedule. Timing is very essential. Our forefathers have emphasized the importance of the need to start cultivation at the right time. We too have to act in a timely manner at this time of strengthening our nation.
